green highlighted text are hebrew or greek words found in strong's concordance that needed a better meaning for that word. the 8pt text is that hebrew or greek word, the following word is noted by using the 1st 2 letters as upright and the rest of the word is italic.

nothing} emptiness

curly brackets { } means hebrew or greek words not needed or needed changing.

brackets [] means text that was moved from one place to another to put words in the correct order. **there are noted (brown text) where they are** and brackets around those words where they went.

orange text are words that might be made into a format, but i did not use those words

plus sign + means the words in that verse needed to be switched to correct for english reading.
